

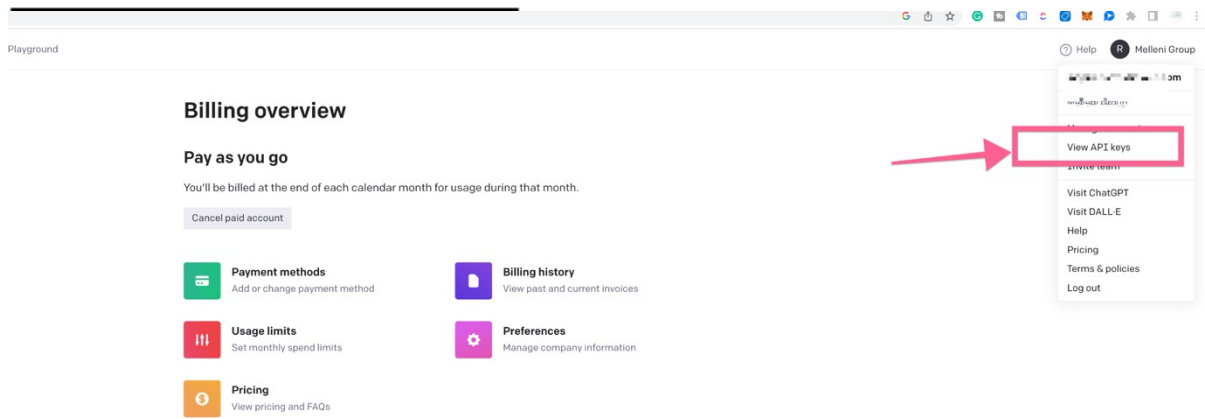
Creating Your API Key

Go to platform.openai.com

To start, navigate to the official website of OpenAI. If you're a new user, set up an account by following the straightforward instructions provided on the site. You'll need to input an email address and a password that will be associated with your OpenAI account. Alternatively, you can conveniently log in using an existing Google or Microsoft account if you prefer.

After setting up an account or if you're returning to the platform, log into your account. Upon successful sign-in, your name and profile icon will be visible at the upper-right portion of the OpenAI platform's main page.

In order to obtain an API Key, select your name located in the topright corner, which will open a dropdown menu. From there, click on the option labeled "View API keys."



At this juncture, you'll land on a page featuring an option to "Create new secret key", usually located towards the middle. If you haven't yet obtained an API key, select this button to generate one. It is crucial that you securely store this API key as soon as it appears. Once the window displaying it is closed, you won't have the capability to view it again.

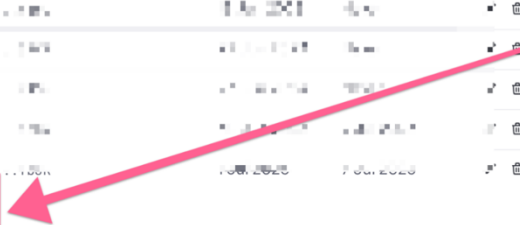
API keys

Do not share your API key with others, or expose it in the browser or other client-side code. In order to protect the security of your account, OpenAI may also automatically rotate any API key that we've found has leaked publicly.
